
Both share with us on Sunday and Wednesday nights in our Bible study.

#### The Election

Messiah told us that we are the light of the world. Lights are not passive. They are active agents, affecting, impacting, transforming their surroundings. We are all and each to affect, impact, and transform the world and people around us in every realm. That includes the political realm. We don't put our faith in it - rather it is a mission field we are to impact.

I had been thinking about just not voting in this election, but I have since realized that as a Child of God, I don't have the option of sitting it out.

The platforms and causes of the two major parties are not the same, or even similar, but are diametrically opposed and on key and central issues given great importance in the word of God.

On the issue of life, one party believes that we should have the right to kill unborn children up to the time of birth. The Bible says that life is sacred and must be protected.
